DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)  
WAC 197-11-340**

**Description of proposal:** Amendments to the city's tree regulations (Chapter 16.14 LFPMC) to clarify various definitions and other provisions and to create a post-approval waiting period for Major Tree permits.

**Location of proposal, including street address, if any:** This is a non-project action. The regulations in Ch. 16.14 and the proposed amendments apply to properties that include or are within the city limits of Lake Forest Park.
