DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
WAC 197-11-340**

Description of proposal: This is a non-project action creating Chapter 12.50 LFPMC establishing criteria regulating the method of construction and the appearance of retaining walls that are built within or adjacent to publicly owned right-of-way that support or protect public transportation infrastructure.
