DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
WAC 197-11-340**

Description of proposal: This is a non-project action for adopting revisions to LPFMC 16.16.250- Reasonable Use Exception. The policy behind the reasonable use exception regulations is to provide a mechanism that protects critical areas and approves the bare minimum amount of use and disturbance when strict application of this chapter would deny all reasonable economic use of a property.
